# **SYNOPSIS**

It's homework time, but the lights are out yet again in Yemen's capital of Sana'a. Three girls, determined to get an education, decide enough is enough. Armed with an entrepreneurial spirit and a sense of creativity, they find a solution to their study woes, addressing their country's weak economy and fledgling infrastructure in the process.

Their idea? Solar powered lanterns. Set against the backdrop of a nation whose reputation includes being one of the worst places to be a woman, the poorest country in the Arab world, and a failed state, the film explores many of the drivers of Yemen's challenges: youth unemployment, drug abuse, and a struggling education system. Even worse, conflict between Al-Qaeda and Yemen's Houthi population threatens the girls' very lives.

In *Yemeniettes*, a team of teenage girls launch a business, taking on titles like CEO and Vice President, while defying the barriers of their traditional society. Together, they prove that age and gender constraints are no match for those seeking to make the world around them a better place.

## **FILMMAKER BIOS**



**Shawn Thompson** (Director & Editor) got his start as an actor in New York City before moving to Los Angeles in 1993 to star in the television series *The Heights*. He received a Gold Record for the soundtrack from *The Heights*, and sang on the number one single "How Do You Talk To an Angel." He segued his career to focus on becoming a writer when, in 2000, he wrote *Four Dogs Playing Poker*, starring Forest Whitaker, Tim Curry and Balthazar Getty. Concurrently, he wrote episodes for the television series *Redwall*. After editing and writing for several films and television shows, he edited the critically acclaimed documentary series *On the Road in* 

America (2007). He also won several awards including the Audience Choice "Best Short Film" in the Beverly Hills Film Festival (2003) for his black comedy, Shotgun Wedding.

In 2009, Shawn once again turned his attention toward directing and completed the powerful documentary short *Life After Death*, which won the "Best Documentary Award" at the Beverly Hills Film Festival (2009). In 2010 and 2011, Shawn was the Editor and Post Producer on the second and third seasons of *On the Road in America*. Shawn has also served as Director and Supervising Editor of the four-episode series, *Generation Entrepreneur*. He is currently the Co-Director and Supervising Editor of *American Caravan*, a reality series in its first season. Shawn lives in Los Angeles and is a graduate of the University of Maryland.



**Leon Shahabian** (Executive Producer & Co-Director) co-founded Layalina Productions in 2002 and currently serves as its President and Executive Producer. Leon executive produced the three seasons of the hit reality series *On the Road in America*, Season I (2007-2008, MBC1 and the Sundance Channel, distributed by Warner Brothers and New Line Television), Season II (2010, MBC1, MBN and OSN), and Season III (2011).

More recently, he created, wrote and executive produced the first season of *Generation Entrepreneur* a youth entrepreneurship reality series (2012-2013, OSN). Currently, he is in production on

Confessions from the War, a film about former fighters in the Lebanese Civil War who must confront their past for the sake of Lebanon's future. .

He also executive produced *Back from the Brink* (2011), a feature documentary on countering violent extremism, and produced and executive produced the award-winning documentary *Life After Death* (2009, Al-Arabiya and MBN). His other credits include executive producing the Sister Cities documentary *Windy City, White City* (2004) as well as *Araeh* (2003).
